

Hi! And thanks for showing an interested in the Elementary Curriculum of Cat and Dog Theology, titled, *Cat and Dog Attitudes*. Here is a quick overview:

- It goes from September to May (30 weeks)
- Each week has 3 lessons (not five, so there is “breathing room.”)
 - Each lesson takes about 20 minutes to complete.
- Every Monday is **teaching**.
 - What does the Bible say about obeying your parents?
- Every Wednesday is **application**.
 - What *could you do* this week to obey your parents to make God famous?
- Every Friday is **accountability**.
 - What *did you do* this past week to make God famous by obeying your parents?
- Here are some of the topics covered:
 - Having A Servant Attitude
 - Respecting Adults
 - Obeying Your parents
 - Loving Your Siblings
 - Loving Others
 - Making Good Choices
 - Doing Your Chores
 - Honesty
 - A Good Attitude
 - Wholeheartedly Serving God
 - Thinking of Others First
 - Encouraging Speech
 - A Good Attitude



Cat and Dog Attitudes covers four subjects in your child’s education:

1. **Scripture Knowledge:** Kids have a teaching and memory verse each week.
2. **World Vision:** You are reading from *I Heard Good News Today 2: Big Life*, which helps children see what God is doing globally.
3. **Geography:** Each time a story is read from *I Heard Good News Today 2: Big Life*, they have to point to the country in Asia where the story is found.
4. **Character Development:** In our cartoon book, *102 Differences Between Cats and Dogs for Kids*, your children are shown practical everyday scenarios. In them, they see examples of how a Cat would react and how a Dog would react. As a result, they are learning how to live in a way that makes God famous!
